

Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must meet the academic qualifications specified in the scholarship announcement.
- Scholarships may be limited to certain nationalities, age groups, or fields of study.
- Proof of admission to an approved institution is usually required.

2. Application Process

- All applications must be submitted by the stated deadline.
